All 118 Rural Development Programmes adopted

The adoption of Greece's Rural Development Programme (RDP) on 11 December 2015 marks the end of the adoption process for all 118 programmes for the 2014-2020 period. With €99.6 billion from the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD) and another €60.6 billion of co-funding from national and regional public funds or private investment, the RDPs will help European rural areas and communities face the current economic, environmental and social challenges, and take advantage of the opportunities ahead of them. European Rural Manifesto

The climax of the European Rural Parliament 2015 campaign was the adoption of a six-page European Rural Manifesto, which expresses the aspirations and demands of rural communities in 40 European countries. This Manifesto will form the basis of the continuing campaign, with action by rural communities themselves and advocacy to regional and national governments and to the European institutions. Continued work of the ERP Steering Group

Steering Group of European Rural Parliament (ERP) continues working on concluding the 2nd ERP activities and launching the preparations for the 3rd ERP in 2017. In short, the call for hosting the next ERP event will be announced. PREPARE, ERCA and ELARD are building strong partnership and close cooperation to build broad coalition of rural initiatives around Europe.

Death of Eero Uusitalo

We report with sorrow the sudden death of our highly valued friend Eero Uusitalo, who until very recently was president of the Finnish Village Association SYTY, a PREPARE partner organization, and the leading figure in rural development policy and action in Finland. He was a great man, and a powerful leader in securing a nationwide, comprehensive and integrated approach to rural development in Finland ... thereby creating an example which is much admired around Europe and has influenced the approach in other countries. Presentations from the 2nd Rural Networks' Assembly

The 2nd Rural Networks' Assembly - the main governance body of the ENRD and EIP-AGRI networks - took place in Brussels on Thursday, 26 November 2015. The Assembly brings together representatives of the main rural development stakeholder groups to provide strategic direction, guidance and advice to the work of the ENRD and EIP-AGRI networks. The 2nd meeting of the Assembly marked the opportunity both to take stock of the first full year of effective implementation of rural networking in the 2014-2020 programming period and to set out the priority directions for 2016. Maximising the contribution of the European Structural and Investment Funds to the Commission's priorities

On 14 December 2015 the Commission adopted a Communication on the contribution of the European Structural and Investment Funds (ESI Funds) to the EU's growth strategy, the Investment Plan and the Commission's priorities over the next decade. The report also includes the outcomes of the negotiations with all the Member States on Partnership Agreements and programmes and the key challenges per country. More ...

On 2 December 2015 the Commission adopted an ambitious new Circular Economy Package to stimulate Europe's transition towards a circular economy which will boost global competitiveness, foster sustainable economic growth and generate new jobs. More ...

Agriculture Council – Sustainable agriculture, school fruit, vegetables and milk schemes and the difficulties in the pig meat sector on ministers' agendas

The EU's Agriculture Ministers met in Brussels on 14 December 2015 for the last Agriculture and Fisheries Council organised under the Luxembourg Presidency. Chaired by Fernand Etgen, the Luxembourg Minister of Agriculture, the Council discussed sustainable agriculture, forestry and fisheries in the bio-economy. The Presidency also informed the Council about the progress of work regarding the proposals for school fruit and vegetables, bananas and milk schemes. Finally, Ministers considered the deteriorating situation in the pork sector. More ...

Agricultural Knowledge and Innovation Systems

On 3-4 December 2015, DG AGRI organised a two day seminar dedicated to promoting understanding of Agricultural Knowledge and Innovation Systems (AKIS) and to highlighting practical examples of the changes taking place in approaches to knowledge transfer, learning and innovation in the agricultural, forestry and rural development sectors. EU Agricultural Outlook Conference

On 1-2 December some four hundred stakeholders took part in the conference upon invitation by the Commission. They represented EU institutions, governments and international organisations, those involved in the food chain, the socio-professional sector, market experts, academics and think tanks, and the broader civil society.
